Some Snow Saturday: Accumulation Likely

Synopsis: An area of low pressure will move up the coast into the day Saturday and combine with cold air already in place, allowing snow to overspread the area. This snow will be steadiest Saturday afternoon, ending Saturday evening from west to east. Snow likely will struggle to stick to pavement initially, thanks to temperatures near or slightly above freezing.

Snow Start: 6AM-8AM Saturday

Heaviest Snow Window: 12 PM to 6 PM Saturday

Snow End: 10PM Saturday to 12AM Sunday

Total Expected Snow (on pavement): 2-4"

Probability of 2" or more: 90%

Probability of 4" or more: 30%

Probability of 6" or more: 15%

Probability of 8" or more: 0%

Snow Type: Wet

Refreeze Risk: High

Refreeze Time: After 10PM Saturday as temperatures drop below 32.

Winds: NNE 5-15 mph

Temperatures: Low to middle 30s
