Showers and thunderstorms likely this afternoon...

Synopsis: A weak cold front looks to move through the region this afternoon and evening, bringing showers and thunderstorms. This does not look like a major severe weather outbreak at this time, but locally heavy rain and damaging winds are possible with these storms.

Storms Start: 4 PM to 6 PM Monday

Storms End: 8 PM to 9 PM Monday

Main threat: Damaging winds and heavy rain

Expected Rainfall: 0.25-1.00" with locally higher amounts

Probability of 0.25" or more of rain: 95%

Probability of 0.50" or more of rain: 75%

Probability of 1.00" or more of rain: 40%

Probability of 2.00" or more of rain: 25%

Winds: SW 10-25 mph, up to 50mph in any thunderstorm

Temperatures: Low 80s Monday afternoon, upper 60s Monday night
